## A TASTE OF HISTORY IN BOYNTON AND DELRAY

A new gastronomic history tour hits the road this Saturday in Boynton Beach and Delray Beach, offering a narrated guide to the area's culinary history. Organized by the **Museum of Lifestyle & Fashion History** (MLFH) in Boynton Beach, the three-hour tour takes visitors by bus and by foot to restaurants of historical interest.

The first Culinary Tour of Historic Boynton Beach and Delray Beach takes off Saturday at 11 a.m., followed by similar gastronomic tours the third Saturday of each month. Each tour stops at two restaurants for tastings and a chat about food and local history.
